T1, INVITATION TO BID

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1.0 Terms of Tender and Tender Overview

1.1 Terms of Tender

- 1.1.1 The terms and conditions applicable to this Tender Process are detailed in Sections T1, T2, and T3, C1 to C7 may only be available with the complete Tender Document following payment of the Tender Fee in the system.
- 1.1.2 SME Bidders are exempted from Tender Fee and Tender Bond.

1.2 About Oman Broadband Company

- 1.2.1 Oman Broadband Company SAOC ("Oman Broadband" or "OBB") founded in 2014 as a joint-stock company wholly owned by the government of the Sultanate of Oman. It is strategically vital to Oman future development serving wider digitization agenda of the Company.
- 1.2.2 Through its visionary and collaborative approach to the market, Oman Broadband will help to empower the nation with high-speed broadband fiber access to citizens and business alike.
- 1.2.3 The next generation fiber optic network will become exponentially faster, bringing community and enterprise benefits of enhanced delivery of communication services, cost savings, increased competitiveness and improved sustainability.
- 1.2.4 Oman Broadband focuses upon the development of a passive fiber network infrastructure, providing equal and open access to telecommunication service providers, on a wholesale basis, and owners and operators of private networks, on a retail basis, thereby enabling end users to efficiently leverage high speed fiber in Oman.

1.3 Description of the Service

Oman Broadband is seeking a Service Provider who can provide transportation services. The contract shall be on a "Call-off" basis and Oman Broadband will be leading the contract during the tendering stage as well as managing the evaluation process. The contract is operationally designed for the daily, monthly, quarterly and annually usages. The scope will include:-

Section 1: Vehicle Leasing & Fleet Provision

- 1.3.1 The transportation services shall be provided for the contract duration of four (4) years.
- 1.3.2 The Service Provider shall provide vehicles on daily, monthly, quarterly, and annual leasing bases as required by Oman Broadband.
- 1.3.3 The Service Provider shall provide vehicle leasing services on demand across all Governorates of the Sultanate of Oman.
- 1.3.4 In the event of an urgent or unforeseen request for additional vehicles, the Service Provider shall ensure the availability of the requested vehicles within one (1) working day.
- 1.3.5 At the commencement of the contract, all vehicles provided under the annual lease shall be brand new, not older than one (1) year, and shall be delivered with zero (0) mileage.
- 1.3.6 For daily, monthly, and quarterly leasing, vehicles shall not be older than model year 2025.
- 1.3.7 The Service Provider shall be capable of providing fully insured vehicles and trucks with varying load-carrying capacities, as and when requested by the Company.
- 1.3.8 The Service Provider shall provide a detailed pricing structure for all vehicle categories, including but not limited to Land Cruiser variants (V6, V8, Standard), Prado, and other models.
- 1.3.9 The Service Provider shall be capable of providing vehicles, buses, and trucks with drivers upon request.
- 1.3.10 The Service Provider shall be capable of supplying vehicles compliant with Oil & Gas industry safety standards upon request.
- 1.3.11 All vehicles shall be white in color. However, alternative colors may be accepted for daily and monthly leasing subject to prior approval from Oman Broadband.

- 1.3.12 The Service Provider shall permit Oman Broadband to apply removable branding and stickers on leased vehicles.
- 1.3.13 All vehicles shall be equipped with a fire extinguisher, first aid kit, and tool kit.

Section 2: Dedicated Fleet Coordinator (Focal Point) & Contract Administration

- 1.3.14 The Service Provider shall appoint a qualified, experienced, and dedicated focal point to manage and coordinate all contract-related services.
- 1.3.15 The Service Provider's focal point shall be stationed at Oman Broadband Headquarters.
- 1.3.16 The Service Provider's focal point shall conduct regular inspections of all vehicles to ensure timely preventive maintenance, tire condition, cleanliness, body condition (including dents), and validity of safety equipment.
- 1.3.17 The Service Provider's designated focal point shall submit a monthly report detailing the status of all vehicle inspections, including maintenance compliance, tire condition, cleanliness, body condition, and safety equipment status.
- 1.3.18 The Service Provider's designated focal point shall submit a monthly report detailing traffic fine settlements, registration renewals, invoices, accident-related costs, daily rental charges, and other contract-related expenses.
- 1.3.19 The Service Provider's designated focal point shall ensure that all vehicle registrations remain valid and are renewed prior to expiry.
- 1.3.20 The Service Provider shall maintain proper records, including vehicle logbooks and delivery, replacement, and return documentation.
- 1.3.21 The Service Provider shall submit monthly invoices supported by relevant documentation, including traffic fine records.
- 1.3.22 Oman Broadband shall coordinate and communicate scheduled maintenance dates with the Service Provider.
- 1.3.23 In the event of an accident or vehicle breakdown, the Service Provider's designated focal point shall coordinate vehicle recovery and arrange suitable transportation for the affected employee.

Section 3: Vehicle Maintenance, Insurance & Replacement Services

- 1.3.24 The Service Provider shall ensure uninterrupted fleet availability through adequate maintenance, replacement vehicle arrangements, and breakdown support services.
- 1.3.25 The Service Provider shall provide maintenance and support services across all Governorates of Oman where vehicles are deployed.
- 1.3.26 The Service Provider shall ensure collection and delivery of replacement vehicles to the relevant Oman Broadband location.
- 1.3.27 The Service Provider shall bear all costs related to preventive maintenance, tire replacement, major servicing, and repairs.
- 1.3.28 The Service Provider shall bear the cost of tire replacement using approved premium brands and shall replace tires every two (2) years or 70,000 km, whichever occurs first.
- 1.3.29 The Service Provider shall be responsible for collecting vehicles scheduled for maintenance or repair.
- 1.3.30 The Service Provider shall arrange vehicle washing services through vouchers, coupons, or agreements with authorized service providers. Oman Broadband shall bear the cost of such services.
- 1.3.31 The Service Provider shall provide a replacement vehicle of the same brand and model or higher specification immediately in cases of accident, maintenance, breakdown, or registration renewal.

- 1.3.32 The Service Provider shall bear all costs related to spare parts, repairs, labor, breakdown recovery, and associated expenses resulting from accidents.
- 1.3.33 All repairs shall be conducted at authorized dealer workshops or certified first-class workshops using genuine original spare parts only.
- 1.3.34 The Service Provider shall be responsible for vehicle insurance coverage and registration renewals, including all associated costs and administrative procedures.
- 1.3.35 All vehicles shall be fully insured against theft, natural disasters, and other applicable risks and shall include AAA roadside assistance services.
- 1.3.36 The Service Provider shall provide comprehensive insurance coverage for all vehicles valid in Oman and the United Arab Emirates (UAE).
- 1.3.37 The Service Provider shall obtain and provide all necessary No Objection Certificates (NOC), permits, and cross-border travel documentation for travel to the UAE as required.
- 1.3.38 In case of accident, Oman Broadband shall bear an insurance excess amount not exceeding OMR 100 per incident.
- 1.3.39 Oman Broadband reserves the right to reject any vehicle where repairs do not comply with the Oman Broadband's safety standards.
- 1.3.40 Oman Broadband reserves the right to reject any vehicle that does not meet acceptable condition standards.
- 1.3.41 Oman Broadband shall be responsible for payment of all traffic and municipality fines incurred during the lease period.

Section 4: Electric, Hybrid & Sustainable Mobility Solutions

- 1.3.42 The Service Provider shall offer electric vehicles (EV), range-extended electric vehicles (REEV), hybrid, and plug-in hybrid vehicles whenever requested.
- 1.3.43 All EV, REEV, hybrid, and plug-in hybrid vehicles shall be brand new models with zero mileage upon delivery.
- 1.3.44 The Service Provider shall provide EV charging solutions, including charging cards and installation of charging stations at Oman Broadband premises if required.
- 1.3.45 The Service Provider shall bear all maintenance and repair costs associated with EV, REEV, hybrid, and plug-in hybrid vehicles, including batteries and electrical components.

Section 5: Vehicle Technology, Safety & Monitoring Systems

- 1.3.46 All vehicles shall be equipped with an In-Vehicle Monitoring System (IVMS), including all associated installation, maintenance, licensing, and removal costs.
- 1.3.47 All vehicles shall be equipped with a speed monitoring and control system, with all associated costs borne by the Service Provider.
- 1.3.48 All vehicles shall be equipped with a biometric vehicle immobilizer system linked to employee identification or an equivalent approved solution.

Section 6: Penalties

- 1.3.49 Penalties for meeting a certain level of service excellence will be applied.

1.4 Minimum Requirements to Participate in Tender

Following is the brief description of minimum eligibility, capability, experience required in order to participate in the Tender:

- 1.4.1 Bidder shall confirm meeting all scope of work requirements mentioned in the tender documents.
- 1.4.2 Bidder shall have handled at least three (3) similar contracts.
- 1.4.3 Bidder shall have a mobilization time within three (3) months
- 1.4.4 Bidder shall be a company duly registered with MOCIIP for the activity of car leasing.
- 1.4.5 Bidder shall provide a representative (focal point) at Oman Broadband HQ.

2.0 Requirements to Collect Tender Document

2.1 Bidder Details Sheet

- 2.1.1 To correctly identify the Bidder and the Bidder's point of contact for this Tendering Process, Appendix 1 *Bidder Details for this Tender* shall be completed by the Bidder and Uploaded in **Oman Broadband's e-Tendering System**.

2.2 Tender Fee

- 2.2.1 The Tender Fee for this Tender is **OMR 1,200**.
- 2.2.2 SME Bidders are exempted from Tender Fee and Tender Bond. However, SME Bidders must submit Riyadh Card.
- 2.2.3 **NON-SME Bidders** shall make the payment of the Tender Fee in Oman Broadband's e-Tendering System through the payment gateway.

2.3 Confidentiality Declaration

- 2.3.1 Prior to collection of the Tender Documents the Bidder shall sign the attached Appendix 2 *Confidentiality Declaration* . The Confidentiality Declaration must be completed, signed by an authorized person, stamped with the Bidders company stamp, and uploaded in **Oman Broadband's e-Tendering System**.

3.0 Oman Broadband Contact Point

- 3.1.1 All communication with Oman Broadband shall be through Clarification Requests, in **Oman Broadband's e-Tendering System**.
- 3.1.2 No Clarification Requests shall be entertained after the Clarification Request Closing Date included in the table below.

4.0 Tender Bond (Bid Bond)

- 4.1.1 To ensure conformance of the Tender, the Oman Broadband requires the Bidder to issue a Tender Bond in the exact format detailed in Section T3. The value of this Tender Bond shall be indicated in Section T3. The Tender Bond shall be forwarded to Oman Broadband as a separate envelop along the tender proposal. The Tender Bond shall be enforced in the event that Bidder fails to submit and substantiate a conforming bid or has failed to accept the award of the contract or purchase order.

5.0 Tender Collection

- 5.1.1 Once the Bidder Details Sheet, Confidentiality Declaration and confirmation of payment of Tender Fee requested above have been received, Bidder may collect the Tender Documents from **Oman Broadband's e-Tendering System** after the request is reviewed and approved by SCM.

6.0 Outline Tender Process and Submission of Bid

- 6.1.1 The Technical Bid and the Commercial Bid are to be submitted in two separate documents.
6.1.2 The opening of the Technical Bid and Commercial Bid is the discretion of Oman Broadband.
6.1.3 The proposed Tender Process schedule is per the following table:

7.0 Contract Award

- 7.1.1 In the event that Oman Broadband considers a Bidder to be commercially a potentially successful competitor for the award of the Contract, Oman Broadband may subject Bidder to a further technical and financial evaluation. Only when a Bidder satisfies Oman Broadband technical, financial and commercial requirements will a Contract be awarded.

10.0 Appendix 2 – Confidentiality Declaration

The undersigned Having its principal office..... (The 'Bidder') hereby declares Oman Broadband Company SAOC ('Oman Broadband') to accept the following terms and conditions on which the Company is prepared to communicate to the Bidder certain Confidential Information pertaining to the Work under the above mentioned Tender as hereinafter defined.

10.1 Definitions

10.1.1 Confidential Information

shall mean all knowledge, data or information acquired by Bidder from, or disclosed to Bidder by the Oman Broadband, or on behalf of Oman Broadband, in connection with the Tender Documents, Clarifications and the Tender Process in writing, drawings, magnetic tapes, computer programs or in any other way, as well as all knowledge, data or information derived there from, to the extent that such knowledge, data or information at the time of such acquisition or disclosure is not either already in the unrestricted possession of Bidder or part of public knowledge or literature.

10.1.2 Confidential Record

Shall mean all Tender Documents, Clarifications and any other material containing Confidential Information.

10.1.3 Third Party

Shall mean any party other than Oman Broadband or Bidder.

10.2 Confidentiality

10.2.1 Bidder shall preserve and cause its employees to preserve the confidentiality of any Confidential Information.

10.2.2 Bidder shall not for any purpose other than the preparation and submission of a Bid

- disclose to any Third Party or enable any Third Party to note the fact that Bidder has been invited to submit a Bid and/or, if applicable, the fact that the Contract is awarded to Bidder;
- reproduce, copy or use, or disclose to, place at the disposal of or use on behalf of any Third Party or enable any Third Party to read, copy or use, any Confidential Information; except with the prior written consent of Oman Broadband.

10.2.3 The undertakings above shall continue insofar and for so long as the Confidential Information or Confidential Record in question has not:

- a) become part of the public knowledge of literature otherwise than through any act or default on the part of Bidder; or
- b) been disclosed to Bidder under an obligation to maintain secrecy by a Third Party (other than one disclosing on behalf of Oman Broadband) who could lawfully do so and who did not derive such Confidential Information or Confidential Record from Oman Broadband.

10.3 Copyright

10.3.1 The copyright in any Confidential Record shall, in the absence of any express provision to the contrary thereon, be vested in Oman Broadband. Copyright in any record containing geological or geophysical data acquired or generated by Bidder in connection with the Contract shall be vested in Oman Broadband.

10.4 Return of Confidential Record

10.4.1 If Bidder declines to submit a Bid or is notified that its Bid is unsuccessful, upon written notification thereof by Oman Broadband, Bidder shall destroy electronic copies and return all hard copy Tender Documents including Addenda and Clarifications to Oman Broadband.

10.5 Third Parties

10.5.1 Bidder shall ensure that if under the terms of this confidentiality agreement any of the Confidential Information comes to the knowledge and/or in the possession of any Third Party, Bidder shall require from such Third Party that it shall abide by stipulations equivalent to those contained in this confidentiality agreement.

10.6 Validity

10.6.1 This Confidentiality Declaration shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the date signed by the Bidder.
